

Dimensionality

Whether you realize it or not, at this very moment, there is a multitude of worlds and realities operating on different vibrational frequencies all around you. We refer to these various densities as “Dimensions.” Each dimension has its own particular variance or nuance associated with its vibratory wavelength, and yet each dimensional level is inextricably linked. The only thing separating dimensions from one another is the wavelengths or the rate at which they are vibrating. This is akin to notes on a musical scale where each tone on the scale sounds different because of its wavelength. Sound becomes inaudible to the human ear as it increases because the sound waves are imperceptible at certain ranges. However, this doesn’t mean the sound doesn’t exist. It simply means whatever exists on these higher octaves is undetectable to human sense.

Sound travels in waves through the air, the ground, and various other substances. Although sound cannot be seen, it can be felt through its vibrations. The number of vibrations produced per second is called a frequency and frequencies vary for each sound and are measured in hertz (Hz). One hertz is equal to one vibration per second and so on. A sound with a low frequency will have a lower density, while sounds with higher frequencies will be less dense. So, as the rate or cycle of vibration increases in frequency, the density lessens to the point where objects are no longer audible to the human ear. Humans cannot hear sounds of every frequency although certain animals have a much higher range of hearing than humans. In fact, the range of hearing for an average human being is only about 20 to 20,000 hertz or cycles per second. Anything below 20 cycles per second or beyond 20,000 cycles per second is outside the normal hearing range but very perceptible to other types of animals. A frequency that is below the human range of hearing is known as “infrasound.” This type of sound is so low it can only be detected with a special device or by a creature with large enough ears such as an Elephant. Research indicates that elephants actually communicate through infrasound. “Ultrasound,” on the other hand, is above the range of human hearing. Animals such as bats, whales, porpoises, and dolphins use ultrasound or sound navigation and ranging (sonar) for navigation. Incredibly most bats can detect frequencies as high as 100,000 Hz.

Right now, at this very moment, there are different colors and sound waves happening all around you of which you are not privy to. Things are happening in the airwaves that only certain instruments can detect. And yet without these devices, you wouldn’t even know about the unseen world of sound waves or things happening beyond the visible light spectrum. At this very moment although you can’t actually hear music playing, there is still a multitude of sound waves being broadcasted on various channels and frequencies. If you were to turn on a radio which is a receiver for certain high pitched frequencies, you would be able to hear these sounds or tones coming from the receiver. As you move the dial from one end of the spectrum to the next, you’re better able to pick up or receive different sounds being broadcasted at certain frequencies. The call sign for most radio stations is generally the frequency at which they are broadcasting. By tuning your dial to these designated frequency bands; you can pick up signals or sound waves. The same holds true for a television and whenever you change the channel, you are actually tuning in to different wavelengths. But without the proper device, this wouldn’t be possible. This is just one example of how there are many levels or dimensions in which things can exist; many of which are not discernable to human sense. However, this does not mean they don’t exist.

So what does all this mean and how does it pertain to dimensionality? Well, it has everything to do with it because octaves are dimensions which determine the overtones on every level. In actuality, there is far more happening on levels that you cannot see or hear than those happening on the physical plane.
