

# Light Workers

---

Light-Workers are highly enlightened beings that have chosen to bring more light to this planet. Light-workers are not Starseeds or Walk-ins but both can become Light-workers once they make a conscious choice to begin their spiritual path and assist others. Unlike Starseeds who have existed in human form for only one or two life-cycles or Walk-ins who have just recently acquired a physical body, Light-Workers have continued to evolve on different planes over a series of countless existences until finally reaching a point of awakened enlightenment. Accordingly, some of us have been with the Earth for millennia, some of us only since Lemuria, some of us only since Atlantis, and some of us only since the end of the “Dark Ages.” By recognizing the divine presence within all beings, the Light-worker is better able to serve humanity.

Light-workers are constantly active in enlightenment or in cultivating enlightenment in others and have taken it upon themselves to help bring others to a more heightened state of awareness. A true Light-worker is any being who is aware of their eternal nature which is the “I Am” presence and acts in accordance with it. Hence, anyone can become a Light-worker after coming into balance and raising their consciousness. Additionally; Light-workers are souls who have a strong inner desire to spread Light, knowledge, freedom and Self-Love on Earth. They are often attracted to spirituality and to therapeutic work of some kind. This often makes them feel different or isolated from other people. By experiencing different kinds of obstacles throughout their journey, they are provoked into finding their own unique path. As a result, Light-workers are usually always solitary individuals, not fitting into fixed societal structures.

The term “Light-Worker” can be a misconception because it suggests that some of us are superior or more enlightened than others. This is not the case because eventually we all become awakened or enlightened. However, some of us have evolved to a greater degree and have already reached a critical point in our evolution because we are older than most souls presently incarnate on Earth. According to Pamela Kribe who channels the being known as “Jeshua,” *“We must understand that a Light-worker is not something we simply are or aren’t, it is something we become, once we go through the journey of experience: experiencing light and dark, actually being light and dark.”* As such; Light-workers possess the ability to attain spiritual awakening much faster than others because they carry within them certain coding for a more rapid spiritual awakening. At the designated time, the individual becomes activated thus allowing them to receive Light in the form of information. It’s an awakening of the spirit which caters to a rapid progression. Because of this, Light-workers appear to be on a faster track than most people. In fact, many of us have lived many, many lives on other planes and reached a particular stage of enlightenment long prior to ever incarnating on Earth. This is what distinguishes us from the rest of Earth’s population. Earth souls are believed to have incarnated in physical bodies here on Earth relatively early in their development. As a result, they started their Earthly journey when their souls were yet in the infant stage while the Light-workers soul had already matured. Light-workers have trouble feeling at home within traditional jobs and/or organizational structures because they are naturally anti-authoritarian which means they naturally resist decisions or values based solely on power or hierarchy. This anti-authoritarian trait is present even if they seem timid and shy. It is connected to the very essence of their mission here on Earth.

Light-workers feel drawn to helping people as a therapist or as a teacher. They may be psychologists, healers, teachers, nurses, (Life Coaches) etc. Even if their profession is not about helping people in a direct manner, the intent to contribute to the higher good of humanity is clearly present.

A Light-worker's vision of life is colored by a spiritual sense of how all things are co-related. They consciously or subconsciously carry memories within them of non-Earthly spheres of light. They may occasionally feel home-sick for these spheres and feel like a stranger on Earth.

Light-workers deeply honor and respect life which often manifests as a fondness for animals and a concern for the environment. The destruction of parts of the animal and vegetable kingdoms on Earth by human doing invokes deep feelings of loss and grief in them.

Light-workers are kind-hearted, sensitive and empathetic. They may have trouble dealing with aggressive behavior and they generally experience difficulties in standing up for themselves.

Light-workers can be dreamy, naive or highly idealistic, as well as insufficiently grounded, i.e. down-to-Earth. Because they easily pick up negative feelings and moods of people around them, it is important for them to spend time alone on a regular basis. This enables them to distinguish between their own feelings and those of others. They need solitary time to touch base with themselves and with mother Earth.

Most Light-workers have lived many lives on Earth in which they were deeply involved with spirituality. They were present in overwhelming numbers in the old religious orders of the past as monks, nuns, hermits, psychics, witches, shamans, priests, priestesses, etc. They were the ones providing a bridge between the visible and the invisible, between the daily context of Earth life and the mysterious realms of the afterlife, realms of God and the spirits of good and evil. For fulfilling this role, they were often rejected and persecuted. Many of them were sentenced to the stake for the gifts they possessed. The traumas of persecution left deep traces within their soul's memory. This may presently manifest as a fear of being fully grounded, i.e. a fear to be really present, because they remember being brutally attacked for who they were.

At present, there are literally millions of self-proclaimed Light-workers active on planet Earth all operating at different levels of consciousness. In fact, if you are reading this, more than likely, you are a probably a Light-worker and you are here to help uplift the vibration of Love and Light on this planet. My spiritual awakening started some twenty years ago during a time in my life when I was at the lowest point of my existence. It was the quintessential "Dark night of the soul." But, like always, it was in the depths of the darkest regions of human nature that this blossoming occurred for me. It's usually at these times when we realize there has to be something more to life than what we've been taught by society, the church, especially the church, our parents, the schools, the media etc...I started on a path of true self-

discovery by seeking to understand (for myself) exactly why I was here on this planet and what purpose I was to serve. It was in that instant that I began to awaken from the illusion (Maya) of my life. That was in 1990 and from that day to this very moment as I write these words; I have continued to pursue the truth of who and what I am.

As a Light-worker, it is incumbent upon me to continuously give back in the form of wisdom and knowledge so that others might be enlightened by not only my experiences but also by my countless years of study and research into spiritual matters. It is not my purpose to keep this knowledge for myself for where much is given much is required. My purpose on this planet is to help change the paradigm of false belief systems through; writing, coaching, lecturing, counseling, teaching, workshops and any other venues that will allow me a platform in which to be heard. It is for this reason that I consider myself to be among the many Light-workers of our time.
